


CURRENT TREND






HANDS ON VS HANDS OFF

Store A: Hands On Stores Average


LOSS PREVENTION NUMBER: \$6,310 DOLLARS SAVED IN JANUARY

- The presence of very high-value products or sudden spike in repeat offenders.






